Thoughts on Self Acceptance

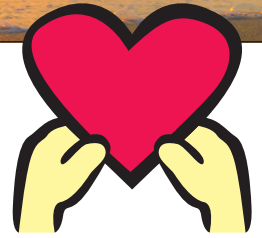
(Inspired by *Voices of Recovery* p.59)

World Service Business Conference Recap

The annual WSBC took place from April 23-28 in Albuquerque, NM at the Embassy Suites Resort. In attendance were 188 voting representatives, including reps from all 50 states of the US + DC and 16 other countries.

The WSBC was overall a fantastic service experience and it was so powerful to see Higher Power at work among this room full of people. No matter the decision, the group accepted it gracefully once the matter was closed and moved on to the next matter. It was so lovely to see "thy will not mine be done" at work on such a large scale. I can't wait to go back next year.

STATE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The number of groups and service bodies is continuing to decrease. Financially we have utilized savings in the past few years to make the budget balance. This year to create a balanced budget the board had to make several cuts. Donations are up but literature sales are down (although this may change with the publication of the new 12&12). The board is looking for other new ways to trim expenses and raise funds. They would like all groups to please consider publicizing the availability of automatic recurring contributions (ARCs), and the possibility of including OA in your will.

The WSBC collected a 7th tradition donation totaling \$15,978.59!

What's New?

Here are just a few new business items addressed at the WSBC:

- The OA policy defining open and closed groups was amended to ensure newcomers understand they are welcome in a closed group meeting.
- A policy stating that OA has no opinion on weight loss surgery was adopted
- The Finance Committee was disbanded.
- The Web/Tech committee was not disbanded.
- Unity Day will now be celebrated on the last Saturday in February in even years and the last Sunday in February in odd years, at 11:30 am local time.
- The OA Birthday, Sponsorship Day and IDEA Day were extended to a whole weekend to allow specific groups/intergroups/regions to decide when they would like to celebrate.
